INSTRUCTIONS

The Veronika Gervers Memorial Research Fund was established in 1979 to honour the work and memory of Veronica Gervers, a pioneering scholar of textiles and dress and former ROM curator. The Fund awards an annual grant to bring one recipient to Toronto to carry out an innovative study on the ROM's exceptional collection of Global Fashion & Textiles, comprised of circa 40,000 objects from around the world and across time.

Applicants can include scholars, curators, educators, conservators, community members, artists, and makers. Projects must contribute new knowledge on some aspect of textiles, dress or fashion—their past, present or future. Through the support of these activities, the grant is meant to enhance access to, and stewardship of, ROM's Global Fashion & Textile collections, and further studies on the critical importance of cloth in the human experience.

The award has two components:

- 1. A study of a select portion of ROM'S Global Fashion & Textiles collections. Maximum of \$9,000, or residency of 2 weeks.
- A public offering which may be a virtual ROM program, ROM emuseum enhancement, in-person presentation, workshop, or podcast.
 The format will be decided in conversations between ROM and the successful applicant.

Eligibility

The award can be made to a person or a group of people. It is open to residents of any country, 18 years and older. Non-Canadian applicants will be responsible for obtaining necessary visas, permits and any other permission that may be required.

Level of Award

A maximum award of \$9,000 CAD is available for the proposed project. The grant can be used for direct expenses related to the project such as transportation, visas, accommodation, supplies, equipment. Applicants without full-time employment are allowed a stipend up to \$2000. The award does not cover travel to other Institutions or top-up of regular salaries. See Budget section of the application for more details.

Award Selection Criteria

- Applicant's demonstrated history of engagement with textiles, dress or fashion
- Relevance and significance of the ROM collection to the project
- Originality and innovativeness of the project, especially toward new perspectives, sources, or methodologies
- Rigour of the project
- Care and clarity of objectives and design of the project
- The viability of the project within the time frame and budget, and how prepared the applicant is to carry out the project
- The contribution of the project to the applicant's professional or personal development
- The impact of the project on wider audiences and communities
- Letters of support

Application Materials

- Completed 2025 Application form. Total application must not exceed 7 pages.
- 2-page resume for the lead applicant(s). If more than one lead applicant, please designate who will be responsible for communication, reporting, and budget.
- 2 reference letters that testify to the applicant's ability to fulfill the proposed project(s). These letters are to be emailed separately and directly to <u>VGerversFellowship@rom.on.ca</u> by the deadline.

Pre-Application Inquiry:

Applicants are strongly advised to contact the museum in advance to seek specific information on suitable and relevant objects and collection areas related to their study before submitting an application.
